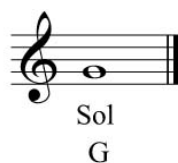
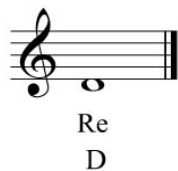


THE C SCALE

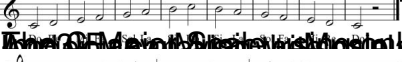
